

## *Sermon Notes*

*October 30, 2022 --- ROMANS 8 – Debtors, Adopted, Heirs, Glorified!*

The answer to the question “Who Am I?” isn’t found in other \_\_\_\_\_, nor is it found in your specific \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ or accomplishments or \_\_\_\_\_.

Romans 8:12-17 is divided into two parts. The first part leads to an answer to the question “\_\_\_\_\_ Am \_\_\_?” The second part describes the \_\_\_\_\_ of that answer.

Within all of us, there is a push and pull between a life focused on the \_\_\_\_\_ and a life \_\_\_\_\_ by the Spirit. But God hasn’t left us to \_\_\_\_\_ for ourselves in this struggle.
